# **PADITEC 45**

Where the *PADI TEC 40* course ends, the *PADI TEC 45* course starts. Take your training as a *technical diver* to the next level: go even deeper into the wonderful depths that the sea of Ustica has to offer and be enabled to make accelerated decompression stops.

## **PADI TEC 45 Program**

What you'll learn during your *PADI TEC45* diver course:

- Use all standard technical equipment (including the double tank). How to configure your technical equipment and check its proper functioning.
- What is the redundancy of the equipment, how to apply it and use it in an emergency
- The procedures to be followed in an emergency during technical diving
- How to calculate and use the SAC (Surface Air Consumption) rate, the partial pressures of the gases, volumes and pressures of a cylinder and the MOD (Maximum Operating Depth) of a mixture.
- Use Deco software to plan dives
- Dive to a maximum depth of 45 meters
- Use a single cylinder with decompression gas containing maximum 100% oxygen for accelerated decompression or to make the necessary decompression more conservative

The PADI TEC45 Diver course is divided into three main parts:

- 1. Knowledge development (individual and classroom study).
- 2. Three practical applications in the classroom.
- 3. Four open water dives to practice technical diving skills.

#### **PADI TEC45 Prerequisits**

To enroll for the PADI TEC45 diver course you need to be at least 18 years old and both a *Rescue Diver* and a *TEC40 diver*. You need to have at least 50 logged dives, from which 12 with nitrox to a depth deeper than 18 metres and 6 dives deeper than 30 metres.

## **Credit/Certification PADI TEC 45**

By completing your course, you will receive your PADI Tec 45 Diver certification, which will allow you to dive up to 45m with decompression and using a decompression gas up to

100% oxygen for accelerated decompression or for more conservative decompression. This certification is a prerequisite for enrolling in the PADI TEC 50 course.
